European Championship will be a great event in a small fishermans village like Borstahusen. Situated just North of Landskrona, between Malmoe and Helsingborg, this summer paradise offers perfect racing waters just outside the well equipped harbour. The organizers have successfully arranged many championships, among those The European Laser Standard Youth and Senior Championship and European Laser Standard Trophy 2009. More than 260 Laser competed on two courses. The winner in Borstahusen was the Olympic gold medalist Paul Goodison.

Race management

The races in Borstahusen are lead by Per-Olof Ekstrand, IRO since more than ten years. Per-Olof has been in charge of races in Europe, South America and Russia. He was IRO for the 470 class at The Olympic Games 2008 in China.


Per-Olof is leading a team of officials who all have been working with most of the races listed on previous page. The Borstahusen team was as well responsible for one of the two courses at Louis Vuitton Acts 6-7 in Malmoe, Sweden 2005, for qualifying to Americas Cup.

Racing Area

The racing area is just outside Borstahusen harbour. The wind is normally from NW-W. In the late afternoon thermal wind is not unusual. There is no tide and the current is shifting from 0,1 up to 1,5 knots.

With races so close to the harbour and the beaches spectators and tourists are presented to an exciting show. The photo below is from 2009 Laser Senior and Junior European Championship. On the piers are flags from 31 nations, among those New Zeeland, Mexico and Malaysia. In the middle of the picture you can see the regatta tent that was built to serve 400 people, i.e. all participants, coaches and delegates.







Facilities

All competing A-Cat will be parked on the harbour and beach area. Jury and coaches boats will be moored in the harbour. Launching will be made from the beaches or slipway. Trailers can be parked 300m south of the harbour. Parking for cars, race office, jury rooms, measurement etc will all be within the harbour area as seen on the map on last page.

Everything for the competitors convinience like showers, toilets etc are close the club-house.

In the harbour is a boat repair shop.

There are two really good restaurants on the harbour. There are two really good restaurants on the harbour. There will also be a tent that will seat all the competitors accompanying delegates and all the officials. There will be full service from early morning until late evening with everything from breakfast, packed lunches and snacks and drinks as well as a number of courses from hamburgers and pasta and upwards. Even the kids will have their own choice

The social events will be held in the tent and The Lord Mayor of Landskrona City is looking forward to host the Gala Dinner with the Prize Giving Ceremony.

There are also restaurants at the nearby 36 hole golf course as well as at the camping site. Just 250 meters from the harbour is a grocery shop.









Accomodation

A very suitable accomodation is Borstahusen Holiday Village, just 900m north of Borstahusen harbour. With 68 cottages (total of 400 beds) in a lush and beautiful park setting this is a perfect and popular choice for visitors to Borstahusen. The majority of cottages have been built or renovated in the last few years. Within walking distance there are the harbour, the beaches, golf courses, restaurants, walking trials, and public transport.

The biggest cottages have three bedrooms with two single beds in each room. Price-level is 750 Euro/week (6 persons). www.borstahusenssemesterby.se

Camping

Borstahusens Camping, just 500 meters from the harbour. It has about 400 pitches for tents or caravans just beside Öresund, and 7 cottages as a more comfortable alternative. There are also 8 rooms, youth hostels style.

Hotels

In Landskrona City, 3 kilometer from Borstahusen, there are 3 fine hotels.

Hotel Öresund has 132 rooms, restaurant, conference rooms etc. Classical hotel with ancestries dating back to the 18th century. One of the largest conference and arrangement hotels in the region. (+3-star-hotel)

Spectators and families

From Borstahusen to the north there are perfect beaches for the families with fresh, clear water. You will have all A-Cats in front of you with the island Ven and Denmark in the background.

A hiking path along the shore over the hills and valleys northward from the beaches will give you an experience of the fashinating beauty of the nature. The path can take you all the way to the harbour Råå in Helsingborg and on the way you will pass small harbours and beaches.

From Borstahusen you can take a 20 minutes (3 kilometer) stroll along the shore to Landskrona. On the way you will pass the Citadell, a fourcorned bastion that was built from 1549. On the ramparts of the Citadell lies Sweden's oldest allotment area with fascinating carpentry work and a profusion of flowers.

In Landskrona there are many shops if you are keen on buying. If that's not enough Helsingborg, Malmö and Copenhagen are not far away. The train to Copenhagen takes

just over an hour from Landskrona.

You are welcome to Borstahusens Golf-klubb, a wellkept park and seaside 36 holes golfcourse. In the southern part of Sweden, Skåne, the golf courses are as common as in Scotland. 20 km from Borstahusen you will find the famous Barsebäck Golf and Country Club where SAS Masters as well as Solheim Cup have been played.

The Island of Ven

In Öresund 9 nm west of Borstahusen is the island Ven, a very much appriciated tourist destination. Ven arose from the sea about 4500 BC and has been settled since the Stone Age.

The grass covered slopes lift Ven out of the sea. Ven is classed as a nature conservation and demonstrates a special flora rich in species. Ven ist best enjoyed by bike and there are 1200 yellow ones for rent. Open air café's, restaurants, cheese from the goat dairy, homemade ice-cream are some of many temptations to give way for.

The Tycho Brahe museum is fascinating. This Danish scientist put the island of Ven on the world map during the renaissance. Tycho built one of Europe's first and finest research institutions to the use of empirical research. The institution included among other things, the spectacular castle Uraniborg, the underground observatory Stjerneborg and a fantastic renaissance garden.







Ways to Borstahusen/ Landskrona

By car

It is less than one hours drive from Copenhagen if you choose the Öresund Bridge. Another option is the ferry between Helsinore/Helsingör-Helsingborg.

Landskrona lies along the E6 highway. From the exit Landskrona North there is less than 3 kilometer to Borstahusen harbour.

Ferries from Poland: Swinoujscie— Ystad (Sweden), Swinoujscie— Copenhagen (Denmark). From Germany: Sassnitz-Trelleborg (Sweden) and Rostock-Trelleborg. Puttgarden-Rödby (Denmark) and Rostock-Gedser (Denmark).

By train

Landskrona station is on the line from Helsingborg towards north and Copenhagen and Malmö towards the south. From the station there is a buss direct to Borstahusen.

By air

It is less than an hour from the airports in Copenhagen/Kastrup, Malmö/Sturup and Helsingborg/Ängelholm.
